RE: PRICE 200m3 water some EU cities!!!
Hey Alejandro -

I find this table quite interesting. In those cities, the average price of 200 m3 of water ranges from 80 euro to 322 euro !!! That's really a very large difference.

And for some countries, there are also large within-country differences. Take a look at the difference between London (140 euro) and Newcastle (275 euro) in the UK, or Helsinki (174) and Turku (254) in Finland. France seems to have more equal water pricing : 268,256 & 265 in the 3 French cities.

Of course, it's difficult to say what these prices reflect: whether abstraction costs in some areas are higher than others, whether prices are raised to induce people to use water more efficiently or whatever... but such a large variability in pricing indicates that there is scope for optimizing pricing strategies in many places.

Hi, -

Because I haven't been able to find the report I was looking for, I can't really answer the question as intended.. SO instead, I'd like to add to the discussion a little perspective about water in less developed countries.

It's estimated that on a global level approx. 3800 children die every DAY from diseases associated with lack of access to safe drinking water, inadequate sanitation and poor hygiene. And approximately 2 BILLION people do not have access to improved sanitation (at least in 2002). The lack of ready availability of safe water is in some regions really a huge burden on population health...

Isn't it a strange thing to think that while we're talking of water pricing in order to give incentives to people to stop wasting water... in other places in the world, people are talking of what incentives can be given to get people to start using MORE water.

Obviously, for us: the idea about more realistic water pricing is good. I think in Denmark, people are very grateful to be able to drink water straight from the taps and I would assume most people would be ready to pay more for water in order to retain the purity of our tap-water.

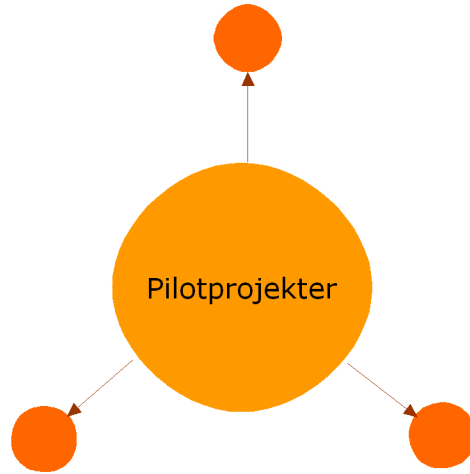

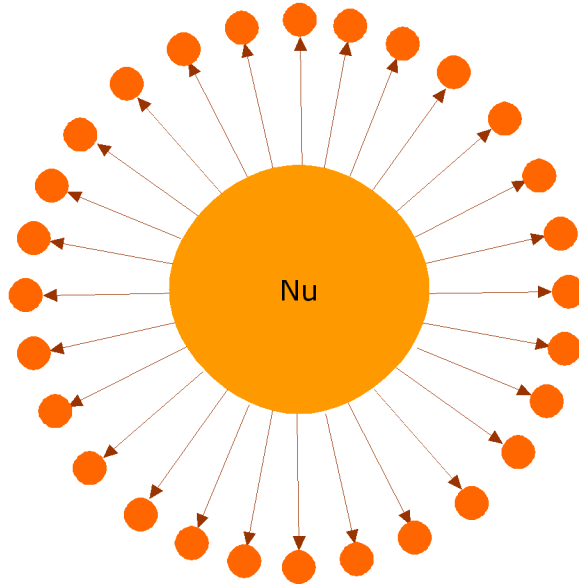

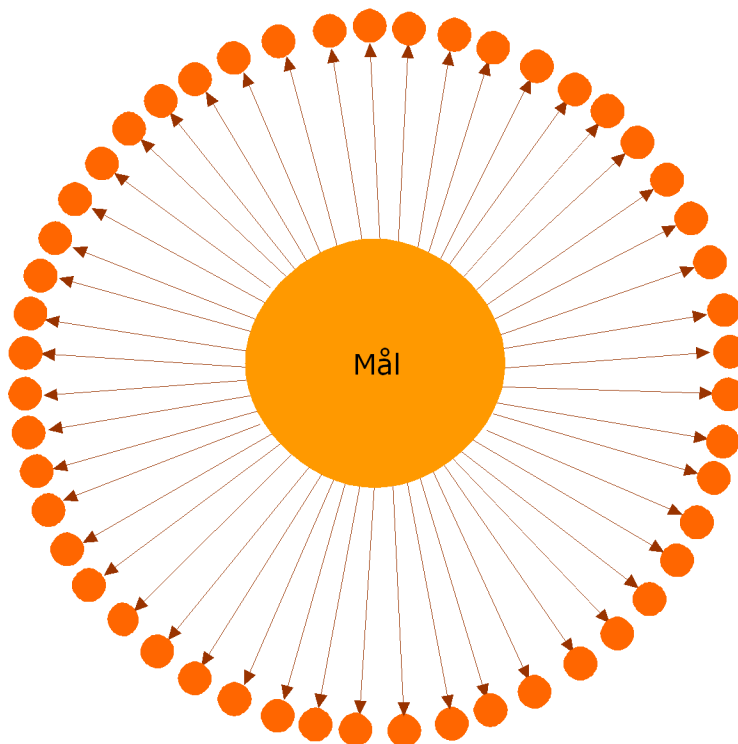
